16	Section 1. EMPLOYMENTQUALIFICATIONSPUBLIC AGENCIES
17	A. All positions in a public agency that require as
18	a minimum qualification that the person employed in that
19	position have obtained a general education development diploma
20	shall allow individuals to be employed in those positions who
21	have not obtained a general education development diploma
22	provided that the new employee obtains a general education
23	development diploma within one year from his date of
24	employment.
25	B. If the new employee has not obtained a general

 presents evidence to his employer that he obtained a general
 education development diploma.

5 C. An employee who fails to obtain a general
6 education development diploma by the first anniversary of
7 employment, as required by this section, shall be removed from
8 his position.

D. As used in this section:

(1) "general education development diploma"
 means a high school equivalency certificate, usually referred
 to as a "GED"; and

(2) "public agency" means an agency of the state or an agency of a subdivision of the state, including universities and community colleges that receive state funds and home rule municipalities.
