12	CHAIRS AT MAJOR RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
13	ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 21-1-27.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2002,
17	Chapter 31, Section 1) is amended to read:
18	"21-1-27.1. FACULTY ENDOWMENT FUND CREATED
19	A. The "faculty endowment fund" is created in the
20	state treasury. The fund shall consist of appropriations,
21	income from investment of the fund, gifts, grants, donations
22	and bequests. Money in the fund shall not revert at the end of
23	any fiscal year.
24	B. The faculty endowment fund shall be administered
25	by the commission on higher education. <u>Except as provided in</u>

<u>Subsection J of this section</u>, money shall be disbursed only on warrant of the secretary of finance and administration upon voucher signed by the executive director of the commission on higher education or his authorized representative.

С. Money shall be disbursed from the faculty 5 endowment fund only to establish endowments for chairs, 6 7 professorships and faculty development programs at four-year 8 public post-secondary educational institutions as provided in 9 this section. Except as provided in Subsection J of this 10 section, an institution shall not receive a disbursement for an 11 endowment until that institution has notified the commission on 12 higher education that it has received matching funds for the 13 endowment from other than governmental sources in an amount 14 that is equal to or greater than the amount authorized by this 15 section to be disbursed for the endowment.

D. <u>Except as provided in Subsection J of this</u> <u>section</u>, money in the faculty endowment fund is appropriated to the commission on higher education to be disbursed for the following endowment purposes in the following amounts:

(1) for endowed chairs, five hundred thousanddollars (\$500,000) for each endowed chair;

(2) for endowed professorships, two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for each endowed professorship; and
(3) for endowed faculty development programs, to include lectureships, graduate fellowships and other faculty

3	E. <u>Except as provided in Subsection J of this</u>
4	section, until June 30, 2005, the following institutions shall

total main campus full-time-equivalent enrollment of all of the named institutions. For purposes of this paragraph, the main campus full-time-equivalent enrollment of each institution shall be based on enrollment figures for the second semester of the 2001-2002 school year.

F. On or after July 1, 2005, money remaining in the faculty endowment fund shall be available for additional disbursements by the commission on higher education to any of the institutions named in this section, subject to receipt of matching funds. Disbursements may be made based on the date requests for additional disbursement are received by the commission.

G. The endowment funds of the institutions shall not be expended but shall be invested by the institutions in accordance with the prudent man rule, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 21-1-38 NMSA 1978. The income from the investments shall be used by the institutions to provide funding for chairs, professorships and faculty development programs, including paying all or a portion of the salary of the faculty member or the expenses necessary to support associated academic activities.

H. <u>Except as provided in Subsection J of this</u> <u>section</u>, disbursements of the faculty endowment fund by the commission on higher education shall be allocated as follows:

be for endowed chairs;

(2) thirty-five percent of the disbursementsshall be for endowed professorships; and

(3) fifteen percent of the disbursements shallbe for endowed faculty development programs.

If the disbursements allocated for endowed 6 Ι. 7 chairs are not sufficient to fund the number of positions 8 specified in Paragraphs (1) through (4) of Subsection E of this 9 section, the number of endowed chairs for each of those four 10 institutions shall be proportioned by the commission on higher 11 education in the same manner as endowed professorships and 12 endowed faculty development programs are proportioned in 13 Paragraph (5) of Subsection E of this section, except that each 14 of the four institutions shall be allocated at least one 15 endowed chair.

J. Up to nine million dollars (\$9,000,000) of the faculty endowment fund may be disbursed after July 1, 2003 to the commission on higher education to endow and disburse the money for one endowed chair each to the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university and the New Mexico institute of mining and technology. Each endowed chair shall be eligible for three million dollars (\$3,000,000) upon notification by the institution that it has received matching funds for the endowment from other than state sources in an amount equal to or greater than two million dollars
