be It enacted by the legl slature of the state of new mexi co:
Section 1. Section 66-3-412 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1979, Chapter 299, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
" 66-3-412. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES- - ONE HUNDRED PERCENT DI SABLED VETERANS- - SUBM SSI ON OF PROOF-- PENALTY. - -
A. The department shall issue distinctive registration pl ates for up to two vehicles, including motorcycles, to a person who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NNSA 1978, and was one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States, upon the submission by the person . 145353. 1
of proof satisfactory to the department that he was one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States. No fee, including the regul ar registration fee appl icable to the passenger mot or vehicle or regul ar motorcycle registration fees, if any, shall be collected for issuance of a special registration pl ate pursuant to this section. A person el igible for a special registration pl ate pursuant to this section and al so el igible for one or mpecial registration pl at es pursuant to Sections 66-3-406, 66-3-409, [ and] 66-3-411 and 66-3-412. 1 NMSA 1978 shall be i ssued onl y one speci al regi stration pl ate of his choice.
B. No person shall fal sel y represent himself to have been one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States so as to be eligible to be issued special registration pl ates pursuant to this section when he in fact was not one hundred percent di sabl ed while serving in the armed forces of the United States.
C. A person who vi ol ates the provi si ons of

Subsection $B$ of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor."
Section 2. EFFECTI VE DATE. - - The ef fective date of the provi si ons of this act is July 1, 2003.
