As such, travel is not a necessary 13 component of commissioners' responsibilities."

Section 3. A new Section 8-8-19.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"8-8-19.2. [NEW MATERIAL] COMMISSIONERS' DUTIES--COMPENSATION. --

Α. Commissioners shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner that maintains public trust and shall be present in the offices of the commission at the seat of government no less than four full working days each week to receive full compensation pursuant to Section 8-1-1 NMSA 1978, unless attending public hearings of the commission outside the city of Santa Fe. Commissioners shall regularly participate in working hearings with appropriate staff so as to fully
