$\underline{A.}$ There is created a "commission for the promotion
of uniformity of legislation in the United States". Its
membership shall consist of:
[A.] <u>(1)</u> two members appointed by the New
Mexico legislative council, who shall be members of the
legislature;
[B.] <u>(2)</u> four members of the New Mexico bar,
