19	A. Every person has a right to inspect [any] public

(3) letters or memorandums [which] that are matters of opinion in personnel files or students' cumulative files:

(4) law enforcement records that reveal confidential sources, methods, information or individuals accused but not charged with a crime. Law enforcement records 7 include evidence in any form received or compiled in connection 8 with [any] <u>a</u> criminal investigation or prosecution by [any] <u>a</u> law enforcement or prosecuting agency, including inactive matters or closed investigations to the extent that they contain the information listed above:

(5) information in a law enforcement record that reveals confidential information about a victim or alleged victim of a crime, including the victim's or alleged victim's date of birth, social security number, address, telephone number, location or other confidential information, which information shall be redacted before disclosure to the public; provided that the victim's or alleged victim's name shall not be redacted except by court order;

[(6)] (7) trade secrets, attorney-client privileged information and long-range or strategic business plans of public hospitals discussed in a properly closed meeting;

[(7)] <u>(8)</u> public records containing the identity of or identifying information relating to an applicant or nominee for the position of president of a public institution of higher education; and

[(8)] (9) as otherwise provided by law. At least twenty-one days before the date of the **B**. meeting of the governing board of a public institution of higher education at which final action is taken on selection of the person for the position of president of the institution, the governing board shall give public notice of the names of the finalists being considered for the position. The board shall consider in the final selection process at least five The required notice shall be given by publication finalists. in a newspaper of statewide circulation and in a newspaper of county-wide circulation in the county in which the institution is located. Publication shall be made once and shall occur at least twenty-one days and not more than thirty days before the described meeting.

C. Postponement of a meeting described in Subsection B of this section for which notice has been given does not relieve the governing body from the requirement of giving notice of a rescheduled meeting in accordance with the provisions of Subsection B of this section.
