18	A. Unlawful carrying of a deadly weapon consists of
19	carrying a concealed loaded firearm or any other type of deadly
20	weapon anywhere, except in the following cases:
21	(1) in the person's residence or on real
22	property belonging to him as owner, lessee, tenant or licensee;
23	(2) in a private automobile or other private
24	means of conveyance, for lawful protection of the person's or
25	another's person or property;

7	completed a course of firearms instruction prescribed by the
