14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONSGENERAL FUND
16	A. One hundred fifteen million two hundred eighty-
17	four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$115,284,800) is
18	appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance
19	and administration for distribution to the appropriate state
20	agency for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to provide four
21	percent cost-of-living salary increases to public employees as
22	follows:
23	(1) fifty-nine million five hundred seventy-
24	four thousand six hundred dollars (\$59,574,600) for public
25	school employees, including transportation employees;

8	thousand two hundred dollars (\$3,261,200) for exempt employees,
9	including attorney general employees, workers' compensation
10	judges and teachers in the children, youth and families

12	and for commissioned officers of the New Mexico state police

14	(b) eighteen million seventy-one
15	thousand eight hundred dollars (\$18,071,800) for classified

2 (6) the following amounts for district 3 attorney employees:

4 (a) two hundred thirty-seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$237,200) for elected district attorneys; 5 6 and

7 (b) six million three hundred forty-four 8 thousand dollars (\$6,344,000) for district attorney permanent 9 employees.

B. For those state employees whose salaries are referenced in or received as a result of non-general fund appropriations in the General Appropriation Act of 2003, the 13 department of finance and administration shall transfer from 14 the appropriate fund to the appropriate agency the amount required for the salary increases equivalent to those provided 16 for in Subsection A of this section, and such amounts are appropriated for expenditure in fiscal year 2004.

Salary increases provided for in Subsections A С. and B of this section shall be effective the first pay period after July 1, 2003.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance of the D. appropriations in this act remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund or other appropriate fund.
