16	Section 1. Section 30-20-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975,
17	Chapter 285, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"30-20-16. BOMB SCARES UNLAWFUL
19	<u>A.</u> Making a bomb scare consists of falsely and
20	maliciously stating to another <u>person</u> that a bomb or other
21	explosive has been placed in such a position that property or
22	persons are likely to be injured or destroyed.
23	<u>B.</u> Whoever [makes] <u>commits making</u> a bomb scare is
24	guilty of a fourth degree felony.
25	<u>C. A court may order a person convicted for the</u>

1	offense of making a bomb scare to reimburse the victim of the
2	offense for economic harm caused by that offense.
3	<u>D. As used in this section, "economic harm" means</u>
4	all direct, incidental and consequential financial harm
5	suffered by a victim of the offense of making a bomb scare.
6	<u>"Economic harm" includes:</u>
7	(1) wages, salaries or other compensation lost
8	as a result of the commission of the offense of making a bomb
9	<u>scare;</u>
10	(2) the cost of all wages, salaries or other
11	<u>compensation paid to employees for time that those employees</u>
12	are prevented from working as a result of the commission of the
13	offense of making a bomb scare; and
14	(3) overhead costs incurred for the period of
15	time that a business is shut down as a result of the commission
16	<u>of the offense of making a bomb scare.</u>
17	<u>E. This section shall not be construed to limit a</u>
18	<u>court's authority to order restitution to a victim of the</u>
19	offense of making a bomb scare pursuant to other provisions of
20	<u>l aw.</u> "
