RELATI NG TO EDUCATI ON; PROVI DI NG FOR ALTERNATI VE SCHOOLS TO BE ELI Gl BLE FOR SI ZE ADJ USTMENT PROGRAM UNI TS; MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 22-8-23 NMEA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1975, Chapter 119, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
" 22-8-23. SI ZE ADJ USTMENT PROGRAM UNI TS. --
A. An approved public school with a MEM of Iess than [400] four hundred, including early childhood education full-time-equi val ent MEM but excl uding membership in class $C$ and cl ass D programs and excl uding full-time-equi val ent nember shi p in three- and four-year-ol d devel opment ally di sabled prograns, is eligi ble for additional programunits. Separate school s establ ished to provi de special programs, incl uding [but . 142710. 1
not linited to] vocational [and alternative] education, shall not be classified as public schools for purposes of generating size adj ustment programunits. Alternative schools approved by the department shall be el i gi ble for size adjust ment program units. The number of additional programunits to which a school district is entitled under this subsection is the sum of el ementary-juni or high units and seni or high units computed in the following manner:

> El ement ary-J uni or Hi gh Units $\frac{200-\mathrm{MEM}}{200} \times 1.0 \times$ MEM $=$ Units
where MEM is equal to the menbership of an approved el ement ary or j uni or hi gh school, incl uding early childhood education full-time-equi val ent membershi $p$ but excluding menbership in cl ass C and class D programs and excl uding full-time-equival ent menber shi $p$ in three- and four-year-old devel opment ally di sabl ed prograns;

MEM is equal to the membershi p of an approved seni or high school excl uding membership in cl ass $C$ and cl ass D prograns.
B. A school district with total MEM of less than [4,000] four thousand, including early childhood education full-time-equi val ent MEM is eligible for additional program units. The number of additional programunits to which a di strict is entitled under this subsection is the number of di strict units computed in the following manner:

District Units
$4000-\mathrm{MEM} \times 0.15 \times \mathrm{MEM}=$ Units 4000
where MEM is equal to the total district membership, including early childhood education full-time-equi val ent membership.
C. A school district with [over 10,000 ] more than ten thousand MEM with a ratio of MEM to seni or hi gh school s I ess than [4,000:1] four thousand to one is el igible for additional programunits based on the number of approved regul ar seni or high schools that are not eligi ble for seni or hi gh units under Subsection $A$ of $t h i s$ section. The nunber of additional programunits to which an el igi ble school district is entitled under this subsection is the number of units computed in the following manner:

Section 2. APPROPRI ATI ON. --Ei ght milli on one hundred thousand dollars ( $\$ 8,100,000$ is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to fund additional program units gener ated by alternative school size adj ustment program units. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shal l revert to the general fund.
