AN ACT
MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON FOR A PHREATOPHYTE ERADI CATI ON AND CONTROL PROGRAM DECLARI NG AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO: Section 1. APPROPRI ATI ON. --
A. Five million dollars $(\$ 5,000,000)$ is appropriated fromthe general fund to the board of regents of New Mexi co state uni versity for expenditure in fiscal years 2003 through 2005 for a non- native phreatophyte er adi cation and control program on the Pecos river and the Rio Grande, the expenditures to be di vi ded equally bet ween the two river basi ns.
B. The appropriation provided in this section is contingent on soil and water conservation di stricts:
(1) devel oping management and native
veget ation restoration pl ans;
(2) conducting hearings within the local conservation districts to recei ve public input on the plans;
(3) carrying out aerial spraying onl y by hel icopter or ground application with prior public notice;
(4) monitoring and eval uating the effects of control on wildlife, water quality, veget ation and soil heal th; and
(5) if control affects threatened or endanger ed speci es, compl ying with applicable federal Iaw and conforming to any dul y enacted recovery pl an.
C. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remai ning at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general f und.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, heal $t h$ and safety that this act take effect imedi at el $y$.
