AN ACT
RELATI NG TO BOATS; REQUI RI NG A BOAT DEALER TO OBTAI N A DEALER LI CENSE; ESTABLI SHI NG A DEALER LI CENSE AND SUPPLEMENTAL LI CENSE APPLI CATI ON PROCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. A new section of the Boat Act is enacted to read:
" [ NEW MATERI AL] BOAT DEALERS- - LI CENSES. --
A. A person shal not engage in busi ness as a deal er without obtai ni ng a valid deal er Iicense from the di vi si on.
B. A person shall file an application for a deal er license with the division. The application shall be in a form prescribed by the di vision. The application shall state that the applicant will engage in busi ness as a deal er. The
statement shall be verified before a state of ficer authorized to administer an oath. The fee for a deal er license shall be prescribed by the di vision but shall not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) annually. The di visi on shall issue a deal er license to an appl icant who submits a complete application and full payment of the deal er license fee to the di vision.
C. A deal er Iicense shall authorize the licensed activity at only one busi ness establishment. A deal er shal I obtain a supplemental license fromthe di vision for each additional establ ishment owned or oper ated by the deal er. The application for a supplement license shall be in a form prescribed by the di vision. The fee for a supplement al Iicense shall be prescribed by the di vision but shal l not exceed t went $y$-fi ve dollars (\$25.00) annually. The di vi si on shal I issue a suppl ement al license to an applicant who possesses a valid deal er license and submits a complete application and full payment of the supplemental license fee to the di vision.
D. A deal er shall display a valid deal er license or a valid supplement al license in the manner prescribed by the di vi si on. "
