B. State park law enforcement officers, in 9

emergency situations, shall be considered on duty and within
the scope of their employment for employee benefits when they
follow specific instructions from a duly qualified full-time
peace officer and aid the peace officer in carrying out his
duties. The secretary shall expand insurance coverage to
provide protection for those situations."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.
