15	Section 1. OFFICE OF MEXICAN AFFAIRSCREATED
16	ADMINISTRATIVE ATTACHMENTPOWERS AND DUTIES
17	A. The "office of Mexican affairs" is created in
18	the office of the governor.
19	B. The head of the office of Mexican affairs is the
20	"Mexican affairs officer". He shall be appointed by the
21	governor with the consent of the senate. The Mexican affairs
22	officer shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.
23	C. Within available appropriations, the Mexican
24	affairs officer may appoint such other professional, technical

The office of Mexican affairs, under the D. direction of the governor, is primarily responsible for 3 conducting the state's relations with the Republic of Mexico 4 and the state of Chihuahua. To the extent allowed by law and necessary to ensure that common economic, political, cultural, 6 7 health and safety and infrastructure issues with the Republic of Mexico and the state of Chihuahua are coordinated. the 8 9 office shall direct or oversee the activities of the economic 10 development department, the tourism department, the office of cultural affairs, the state highway and transportation 11 12 department, the department of health, the department of environment, the department of public safety, the New Mexico 13 border commission, the border authority and the joint border 14 research institute at New Mexico state university as those activities relate to improving New Mexico-Mexico relations and 16 trade and encouraging or funding appropriate border 17 18 development.

APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred twenty-five Section 2. thousand dollars (\$325,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of the governor for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 for operations of the office of Mexican affairs. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.
