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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. A new section of the Public School Code is
18	enacted to read:
19	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL]</u> CENTER ESTABLISHEDPOWERS AND DUTIES
20	A. The department of education shall establish
21	within the department a "center for rural and Native American
22	education", which shall be located in northwest New Mexico to
23	provide teachers in rural and Native American school districts
24	who have limited access to educational resources with the
25	knowledge and skills necessary to address the needs of
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1 culturally and linguistically diverse students from rural and Native American communities. 2

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R The center shall:

provide professional development for (1)teachers who work with Native American students, bilingual 5 students and students from low socioeconomic backgrounds; 6

(2)collaborate with institutions of higher education, public schools, teachers and tribal governments to plan educational activities and learning opportunities;

design, develop and make available to (3) teachers curricula specific to the four core content areas of reading-language arts, mathematics, science and social studies, with emphasis on speaking, reading and writing, and ensure that the curricula align with state content standards and benchmarks:

develop models for the recruitment, (4) retention and support of teachers who are qualified to provide instruction to culturally and linguistically diverse students to ensure improved student achievement;

(5) research how teachers may best provide speaking, reading and writing instruction to culturally and linguistically diverse student populations;

disseminate to teachers effective models (6) to improve academic success for culturally and linguistically diverse students in the four core content areas;

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1 (7) collaborate with the office of Indian 2 education to ensure that work and programs are not duplicated; develop policy recommendations related to 3 (8) professional development models and effective reading and 4 teaching strategies that assist culturally and linguistically 5 diverse students to become successful learners: and 6 7 (9) provide other technical assistance to teachers, public schools and school districts as approved by 8 9 the department of education. 10 С. The department of education shall: employ a director and other staff to carry 11 (1)12 out the purpose of the center; ensure that the center collaborates with (2)13 school districts and addresses the needs of the school 14 districts and their students and that the activities of the 15 16 center are aligned with the educational plans of school districts: 17 ensure that the center promotes progress 18 (3) in student achievement as set forth in the state accountability 19 20 system; collaborate with institutions of higher 21 (4) education in research activities associated with the center and 22 disseminate such research findings to support the development 23 of policy and programs that improve the instructional 24 methodology of teachers of culturally and linguistically 25 . 142726. 1

(5) evaluate the center using both formative 3 and summative data and report annually with recommended funding 4 for the following year to the legislative education study committee, legislative finance committee, state board and office of the governor." 6

APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred thousand dollars Section 2. (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to establish and conduct the center for rural and Native American education. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.

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
