19	A. [ <del>Each</del> ] <u>A</u> lobbyist or lobbyist's employer who

8	total separate amounts spent on:
9	(a) meals and beverages;
10	(b) other entertainment expenditures;

the aggregate for each election to a candidate, a campaign committee or anyone authorized by a candidate to receive funds on his behalf.

B. If the expenditure report is filed electronically, the report shall be subscribed and sworn to in an independent affidavit that shall be delivered to the secretary of state within forty-eight hours after the expenditure report is electronically filed.

In identifying expenditures pursuant to the **C**. provisions of Paragraph (1) of Subsection A of this section, any individual expenditure that is more than the threshold level established in the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that must be reported separately to claim a business expense deduction, as published by the secretary of state, shall be identified by amount, date, purpose, type of expenditure and name of the person who received or was benefitted by the expenditure; provided, in the case of special events, including parties, dinners, athletic events, entertainment and other functions, to which all members of the legislature, to which all members of either house or any legislative committee or to which all members of a board or commission are invited, expenses need not be allocated to each individual who attended, but the date, location, name of the body invited and total expenses incurred shall be reported.

of the Lobbyist Regulation Act shall be filed:

by January 15 for all expenditures and 2 (1)political contributions made or incurred during the preceding 3 4 year and not previously reported;

within forty-eight hours for each separate (2)expenditure made or incurred during a legislative session that 6 7 was for five hundred dollars (\$500) or more; and

by May 1 for all expenditures and 8 (3) political contributions made or incurred through April 25 of the 9 10 current year and not previously reported.

A lobbyist's personal living expenses and the **E**. expenses incidental to establishing and maintaining an office in connection with lobbying activities or compensation paid to a lobbyist by a lobbyist's employer need not be reported.

F. A lobbyist or lobbyist's employer shall obtain and preserve all records, accounts, bills, receipts, books, papers and documents necessary to substantiate the financial statements required to be made under the Lobbyist Regulation Act for a period of two years from the date of filing of the report containing such items. When the lobbyist is required under the terms of his employment to turn over any such records to his employer, responsibility for the preservation of them as required by this section and the filing of reports required by this section shall rest with the employer. [Such] The records shall be made available to the secretary of state or attorney

2 G. [Any] <u>A</u> lobbyist's employer who also engages in
3 lobbying shall comply with the provisions of the Lobbyist
4 Regulation Act.

H. An organization of two or more persons, including 5 an individual who holds himself out as an organization, that 6 7 within one calendar year expends funds in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) not otherwise reported under the 8 Lobbyist Regulation Act to conduct an advertising campaign for 9 10 the purpose of lobbying shall register with the secretary of state within forty-eight hours after expending two thousand five 11 12 hundred dollars (\$2,500). [Such] The registration shall 13 indicate the name of the organization and the names, addresses and occupations of any of its principals, organizers or officers 14 and shall include the name of any lobbyist or lobbyist's 15 employer who is a member of the organization. Within fifteen 16 days after a legislative session, the organization shall report 17 the contributions, pledges to contribute, expenditures and 18 commitments to expend for the advertising campaign for the 19 purpose of lobbying, including the names, addresses and 20 occupations of the contributors, to the secretary of state on a 21 prescribed form." 22

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.
