AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOBACCO SETTLEMENT PROGRAM  
FUND TO ESTABLISH A MULTIDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH PROGRAM IN HUMAN  
GENOMICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO; DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two million three hundred  
eighty thousand dollars (\$2,380,000) is appropriated from the  
tobacco settlement program fund to the board of regents of the  
university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal years 2003  
through 2005 to support a multidisciplinary human genomics  
research program for the university of New Mexico cancer  
center, school of medicine and health sciences center, to  
provide clinical care, investigate prevention and treatment of  
tobacco-related diseases and assess relationships between

1 various contaminants and diseases throughout the state. Any  
2 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
3 fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the tobacco settlement program  
4 fund.

5 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
6 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
