AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOBACCO SETTLEMENT PROGRAM
FUND TO ESTABLISH A MULTIDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH PROGRAM IN HUMAN
GENOMICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two million three hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$2,380,000) is appropriated from the tobacco settlement program fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal years 2003 through 2005 to support a multidisciplinary human genomics research program for the university of New Mexico cancer center, school of medicine and health sciences center, to provide clinical care, investigate prevention and treatment of tobacco-related diseases and assess relationships between
