14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
16	A. One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated
17	from the general fund to the human services department for
18	expenditure in fiscal years 2003 and 2004 for the purpose of
19	contracting for various services and programs statewide for
20	homeless persons, as follows:
21	(1) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
22	to fund emergency shelters, for transitional housing and for
23	mental health services for the homeless, veterans services and
24	case management services;
25	(2) two hundred fifty thousand dollars

1	(\$250,000) to match federal funds for the development and
2	operation of permanent supportive housing for disabled
3	homeless; and
4	(3) two hundred fifty thousand dollars

7	assistance to those on the verge of becoming homeless.
8	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
9	at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general
10	fund.
