19	"66-3-16.1. PROHIBITED ACTSPENALTIES
20	A. Any person who provides false information in
21	order to acquire, or who assists an unqualified person to
22	acquire, a special registration plate or parking placard as
23	provided in Section 66-3-16 NMSA 1978 is guilty of a
24	misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions
25	of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.

B. Any person, other than the person to whom a special registration plate or a parking placard was issued, who in the absence of the holder of the plate or placard, parks in a designated disabled parking space while displaying the plate or placard, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.

8 C. The holder of a special registration plate or 9 parking placard shall not give or lend his plate or placard to 10 another person for use when the holder is not in the motor 11 vehicle. For a first offense pursuant to this subsection, the 12 department shall suspend the holder's privilege to have a 13 special registration place or parking placard for six months. 14 For a second offense, the department shall permanently revoke 15 the holder's privilege to have a special registration plate or 16 parking placard.

[C.-] D. A special registration plate or parking placard displayed on a vehicle parked in a designated disabled parking space in the absence of the holder of that plate or placard, is subject to immediate seizure by a law enforcement official and if seized shall be delivered to the division within seventy-two hours.

<u>E.</u> Failure to surrender the parking placard on demand of a law enforcement officer <u>or the department</u> is a petty misdemeanor and punishable by a fine not to exceed one .143651.1

Section 2. Section 66-7-352.5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, Chapter 45, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-7-352.5. UNAUTHORIZED USE--PENALTIES.--

A. It is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle not displaying a special registration plate or a parking placard issued pursuant to Section 66-3-16 NMSA 1978 in a designated disabled parking space.

B. It is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle in such a manner so as to block access to any part of a curb cut designed for access by persons with severe mobility impairment.

C. Any person convicted of violating Subsection A or B of this section is subject to a fine of not less than [one <u>hundred dollars (\$100)</u>] <u>two hundred fifty dollars (\$250)</u> or more than [three hundred dollars (\$300)] <u>four hundred fifty</u> <u>dollars (\$450)</u>. Failure to properly display a parking placard or special registration plate issued pursuant to Section 66-3-16 NMSA 1978 is not a defense against a charge of violation of Subsection A or B of this section.

D. A vehicle parked in violation of Subsection A or B of this section is subject to being towed at the expense of the vehicle owner upon authorization by law enforcement personnel or by the property owner or manager of a parking lot."
