AN ACT
RELATI NG TO GAM NG; EXPANDI NG THE PARTI ES WTH WHOM THE NEW MEXI CO LOTTERY AUTHORI TY MAY CONTRACT TO OFFER J O NT LOTTERY GAMES; AMENDI NG THE NEW MEXI CO LOTTERY ACT; DECLARI NG AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO: Section 1. Section 6-24-6 NMEA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1995, Chapter 155, Section 6) is amended to read:
"6-24-6. POVERS OF THE AUTHORI TY. --
A. The authority shall have [any and] all powers necessary or conveni ent to carry out and effectuate the purposes and provisions of the New Mexi co Lottery Act that are not in conflict with the constitution of New Mexico and that are generally exerci sed by corporations engaged in entrepreneurial pursuits, including [but without liniting the . 142118. 1
generality of the foregoing] the power to:
(1) sue and be sued;
(2) adopt and alter a seal;
(3) adopt, amend and repeal byl aws, rules, pol icies and procedures for the conduct of its affairs and its busi ness;
(4) procure or provi de i nsurance;
(5) hol d copyrights, trademarks and service marks and enforce its rights with respect thereto;
(6) initiate, supervise and admini ster the oper ation of the lottery in accordance with the provi si ons of the New Mexi co Lottery Act and rules, policies and procedures adopted pursuant to that act;
(7) enter into written agreements [ on of fore other states] or contracts for the operation, partici pation in or marketing or promotion of a oint lottery or j oi nt I ottery games with operators of a lottery:
(a) in one or more ot her states;
(b) in a territory of the United States;
(c) in one or more political
subdi visions of another state or territory of the United St ates;
(d) in a soverei gn nation;
(e) in an I ndian nation, tribe or pueblo
located within the United States; or

## Uni ted St ates;

(8) acqui re or lease real property and make i mprovements thereon and acquire by lease or by purchase personal property, including [but not limitedto] computers, mechani cal, el ectronic and on-I ine equi prent and terminals and i nt angi ble property, incl uding [but not limited to] computer prograns, systens and sof tware;
(9) enter into contracts to incur debt and borrow money in its own name and enter into financing agreements with the state, with agencies or instrumentalities of the state or with any commercial bank or credit provider;
(10) recei ve and expend, in accordance with the provisions of the New Mexico Lottery Act, all money recei ved fromany lottery or nonl ottery source for effectuating the purposes of the New Mexi co Lottery Act;
(11) admi ni ster oaths, take depositions, i ssue subpoenas and compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, papers, documents and ot her evi dence rel ative to any investigation or proceeding conducted by the authority;
(12) appoi nt and prescribe the duties of officers, agents and empl oyees of the authority, incl uding prof essi onal and administrative staff and personnel, and to fix thei $r$ compensation, pay thei $r$ expenses and provide a benefit . 142118. 1
program incl uding [but not limited to] a retirement pl an and a group insurance plan;
(13) sel ect and contract with lottery vendors and I ottery retailers;
(14) enter into contracts or agreements with state, local or federal I aw enforcement agencies or private i nvesti gat ors or other persons for the performance of Iaw enf or cement, background investigations and security checks;
(15) enter into contracts of [any and] all types on such terns and conditions as the authority may det er min ne;
(16) establ ish and mai nt ai $n$ banki ng rel ationshi ps, incl udi ng [but not limited to] establ i shment of checking and savi ngs accounts and Iines of credit;
(17) advertise and promote the I ottery and I ot tery games;
(18) act as a lottery retailer, conduct prometions that invol ve the dispensing of lottery tickets and establish and operate a sal es facility to sell lottery tickets and any rel ated merchandi se; and
(19) adopt, repeal and amend such rul es, pol icies and procedures as necessary to carry out and implement its powers and duties, organi ze and operate the authority, conduct lottery games and any other matters necessary or desirable for the efficient and effective operation of the . 142118. 1

I ottery and the conveni ence of the public.
B. The powers enumerated in this section are cumul ative of and in addition to those powers enumerated el sewhere in the New Mexi co Lottery Act, and no such powers Iimit or restrict any other powers of the authority." Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect imedi ately.
