RELATING TO MEDICAID; DIRECTING THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT

TO ESTABLISH A WAIVER PROGRAM TO PROVIDE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS FOR

CERTAIN SENIORS AND DISABLED PERSONS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION;

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PRESCRIPTION DRUG WAIVER PROGRAM-PURPOSE-ELIGIBILITY.--Subject to the availability of state funds and
consistent with the federal Social Security Act, the human
services department shall create a medicaid waiver program and
may by regulation provide prescription drugs to persons whose
incomes are less than one hundred eighty-five percent of the
federal poverty level and who:

- A. are sixty-five years of age or older; or
- B. have been determined to be disabled under the

criteria established under the federal social security administration's disability determination rules as applied by the department.

APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand Section 2. dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2003 and 2004 for the purpose of establishing a program to provide prescription drugs to certain seniors and disabled persons, by applying to the federal centers for medicare and medicaid services for a Title 19 waiver of the state's medicaid program. The department shall include, to the extent practicable, costsharing provisions so as to minimize state general fund This appropriation includes funds for expendi tures. application, start-up and outreach efforts. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.

EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public Section 3. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
