## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STATEWIDE INFORMATION AND REFERRAL TASK FORCE AND A PILOT PROGRAM OF THE "211"

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL PROGRAM IN DONA ANA COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the developmental disabilities planning council for expenditure in fiscal years 2003 and 2004 to establish an information and referral task force and to develop a pilot "211" information and referral program in Dona Ana county as follows:

 $(1) \quad sixty \ thousand \ dollars \ (\$60,000) \ to$  establish an information and referral task force to develop a  $.\, 144843.\, 1$ 

statewide, comprehensive "211" information and referral plan, including a tariff structure based on existing agreements, a common taxonomy of terms, coordination between public and private systems and standardized statewide training and exploration of a centralized information repository. The task force shall include representation from the department of health; the human services department; the children, youth and families department; the labor department; the state agency on aging; the long-term care link program, the governor's committee on concerns of the handicapped; the commission for the blind; the commission for deaf and hard-of-hearing persons; a statewide organization that raises money for health and human service purposes; and other interested parties; and

- (2) ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to develop and implement a pilot "211" information and referral project in Dona Ana county.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.
- Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
