## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

### Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state agency on aging for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 for the following purposes:

- (1) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to fund respite care services for families of persons with Alzheimer's disease, with emphasis on services in rural areas; and
- (2) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for staff development for administrative and direct care staff in nursing homes, assisted living facilities and community-based
