15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS

18	the specified purposes for expenditure in fiscal year 2004:
19	(1) six million dollars (\$6,000,000) to the
20	department of health for comprehensive tobacco use prevention
21	and cessation programs that are community-based, culturally
22	appropriate and designed to achieve the "best practices"
23	standards developed by the federal centers for disease control

25	programs, media and public awareness campaigns and partnerships
