AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; DESIGNATING A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE FOR SEARCH AND RESCUE MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code, Section 1. Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:

[NEW MATERIAL] SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR "66-3-424. SEARCH AND RESCUE MEMBERS. - -

- The department shall issue a distinctive registration plate indicating that the recipient is a search and rescue member.
- For a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), which shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees, a motor vehicle owner who is a search and rescue member may apply for the issuance of a special registration plate as

defined in Subsection A of this section. No two owners shall be issued identically lettered or numbered plates.

- C. The fifteen-dollar (\$15.00) fee provided in Subsection B of this section shall be waived for each registration period in which a validating sticker is issued under the provisions of Section 66-3-17 NMSA 1978, in lieu of the issuance of a special search and rescue member plate.
- D. The revenue from the special search and rescue member registration plate fee imposed by Subsection B of this section shall be distributed as follows:
- (1) seven dollars (\$7.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be retained by the department and is appropriated to the department for the manufacture and issuance of the registration plates; and
- (2) eight dollars (\$8.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be paid to the state treasurer for credit to the motor vehicle suspense fund for distribution in accordance with Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978."
- Section 2. Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 358, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-6-23. DISPOSITION OF FEES. --

A. After the necessary disbursements for refunds and other purposes have been made, the money remaining in the motor vehicle suspense fund, except for remittances received within the previous two months that are unidentified as to source or

disposition, shall be distributed as follows:

- (1) to each municipality, county or fee agent operating a motor vehicle field office:
- (a) an amount equal to six dollars (\$6.00) per driver's license and three dollars (\$3.00) per identification card or motor vehicle or motorboat registration or title transaction performed; and
- (b) for each such agent determined by the secretary pursuant to Section 66-2-16 NMSA 1978 to have performed ten thousand or more transactions in the preceding fiscal year, other than a class A county with a population exceeding three hundred thousand or [any] a municipality with a population exceeding three hundred thousand that has been designated as an agent pursuant to Section 66-2-14.1 NMSA 1978, an amount equal to one dollar (\$1.00) in addition to the amount distributed pursuant to Subparagraph (a) of this paragraph for each driver's license, identification card, motor vehicle registration, motorboat registration or title transaction performed;
- (2) to each municipality or county, other than a class A county with a population exceeding three hundred thousand or a municipality with a population exceeding three hundred thousand designated as an agent pursuant to Section 66-2-14.1 NMSA 1978, operating a motor vehicle field office, an amount equal to fifty cents (\$.50) for each administrative service fee remitted by that county or municipality to the department pursuant to the

2	(3) to the state road fund:
3	(a) an amount equal to the fees collected
4	pursuant to Section 66-7-413.4 NMSA 1978;

8	fee collected by the department employees from an applicant to
9	whom a license is granted after deducting from the driver's
10	license fee the amount of the distribution authorized in Paragraph

13	(d) an amount equal to fifty percent of the
14	fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-19 NMSA 1978;
15	(4) to the local governments road fund, the
16	amount of the fees collected pursuant to Subsection B of Section
17	66-5-33.1 NMSA 1978 and the remainder of the fees collected
18	pursuant to Subsection A of Section 66-5-408 NMSA 1978;
19	(5) to the department:
20	(a) any amounts reimbursed to the
21	department pursuant to Subsection C of Section 66-2-14.1 NMSA
22	1978;
23	(b) an amount equal to two dollars (\$2.00)
24	of each motorcycle registration fee collected pursuant to Section
25	66-6-1 NMSA 1978;

(c) an amount equal to the fees provided
for in Subsection D of Section 66-2-7 NMSA 1978, Subsection E of
Section 66-2-16 NMSA 1978, Subsections J and K of Section 66-3-6
NMSA 1978 other than the administrative fee, Subsection C of
Section 66-5-44 NMSA 1978 and Subsection B of Section 66-5-408
NMSA 1978;
(d) the amounts due to the department

- (d) the amounts due to the department pursuant to Paragraph (1) of Subsection E of Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978, Subsection E of Section 66-3-422 NMSA 1978 [and], Subsection E of Section 66-3-423 NMSA 1978 and Paragraph (2) of Subsection D of Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978; and
- (e) an amount equal to the registration fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-6.1 NMSA 1978 for the purposes of enforcing the provisions of the Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act and for creating and maintaining a multilanguage noncommercial driver's license testing program;
- (6) to each New Mexico institution of higher education, an amount equal to that part of the fees distributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection D of Section 66-3-416 NMSA 1978 proportionate to the number of special registration plates issued in the name of the institution to all such special registration plates issued in the name of all institutions;
- (7) to the armed forces veterans license fund, the amount to be distributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection E of Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978;

4	(9) to the state highway and transportation
5	department, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to

9	act, an amount equal to one hundred percent of the driver safety
10	fee collected pursuant to Subsection D of Section 66-5-44 NMSA

12	(11) to the motorcycle training fund, two
13	dollars (\$2.00) of each motorcycle registration fee collected
14	pursuant to Section 66-6-1 NMSA 1978;
15	(12) to the highway infrastructure fund, all
16	tire recycling fees collected pursuant to the provisions of
17	Sections 66-6-1, 66-6-2, 66-6-4, 66-6-5 and 66-6-8 NMSA 1978;
18	(13) to each county, an amount equal to fifty
19	percent of the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-19 NMSA
20	1978 multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of which is the total
21	mileage of public roads maintained by the county and the
22	denominator of which is the total mileage of public roads
23	maintained by all counties in the state; and
24	(14) to the litter control and beautification
25	fund, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to Section

66-6-6.2 NMSA 1978.

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The balance, exclusive of unidentified remittances, В. shall be distributed in accordance with Section 66-6-23.1 NMSA 1978.

If any of the paragraphs, subsections or sections referred to in Subsection A of this section are recompiled or otherwise redesignated without a corresponding change to Subsection A of this section, the reference in Subsection A of this section shall be construed to be the recompiled or redesignated paragraph, subsection or section."

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.

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
