17	Section 1. A new section of the Family Violence

20	APPEARANCE BY A MINOR FOURTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER
21	A. A minor fourteen years of age or older may
22	appear in court without being accompanied by a parent, guardian
23	or guardian ad litem to petition the court for an order of
24	protection or to oppose an order of protection.
25	B. The court, upon its own motion, may appoint a

representative for a minor to assist the minor with a petition for an order of protection or the minor's action to oppose an order of protection. The appointment of a representative for a minor shall not delay the proceedings.

C. If the court issues an order of protection and the minor is residing with a parent or guardian, the court shall send a copy of the order of protection to a parent or guardian designated by the minor. The court is not required to send a copy of an order of protection to more than one parent or guardian of a minor.

D. The court may elect not to provide a copy of an order of protection to a parent or guardian of a minor if, in the court's judgment, it would not be in the best interests of the minor."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.
