- Section 1. LAW ENFORCEMENT--LAWS REGARDING AIRCRAFT-POWER TO INSPECT FACILITIES RELATED TO AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS.--
- A. A New Mexico state police officer or a municipal police officer shall enforce and assist in the enforcement of all state and municipal laws, and rules adopted pursuant to those laws, regarding aircraft.
- B. A New Mexico state police officer or a municipal police officer may inspect and examine, at a reasonable hour, the premises and buildings on the premises where:
- (1) airports, air navigation facilities or flight schools are operated; or
 - (2) other activities related to aircraft are
