AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CAPITOL BUILDINGS PLANNING COMMISSION;  
PROVIDING FOR TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 15-10-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,  
Chapter 178, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"15-10-1. CAPITOL BUILDINGS PLANNING COMMISSION  
CREATED. --

A. The "capitol buildings planning commission" is  
created to study and plan for the long-range facilities needs  
of state government in Santa Fe and Albuquerque. The  
commission shall review prior long-range facilities needs  
assessments and develop an initial master plan for the state  
facilities in Santa Fe and Albuquerque.

B. The commission shall be composed of four members

1 of the legislature, two from each house, appointed by the New  
2 Mexico legislative council, the secretary of general services,  
3 the New Mexico staff architect, the secretary of highway and  
4 transportation or his designee, the director of the museum of  
5 New Mexico or his designee, the secretary of finance and  
6 administration or his designee, the commissioner of public  
7 lands or his designee and the chairman of the supreme court  
8 building commission or his designee.

9 C. The legislative council service shall provide  
10 staff for the commission in coordination with the staff of the  
11 general services department.

12 D. The commission shall meet regularly and shall  
13 report annually to the legislature on an annual update of the  
14 master plan for the long-range facilities needs of state  
15 government in Santa Fe and Albuquerque. "
