contract with a medical-educational institution that provides
intensive specialized auditory oral education to provide
auditory oral education and follow-up treatment to deaf
students who have been treated surgically with multichannel
cochlear implants. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the
general fund.
