16	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONSeven hundred fifty thousand
17	dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
18	state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal
19	years 2004 through 2007 to support programs that provide
20	holistic, agricultural farming experience to school-aged youth
21	in New Mexico. No more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars
22	(\$250,000) may be expended in any one fiscal year. Any
23	unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
24	fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
