16	Section 1. Section 17-4-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1912,
17	Chapter 85, Section 59, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"17-4-8. GAME <u>AND</u> FISHPROPAGATING IN PRIVATE [LAKE]
19	LAKES OR [PARK] BODIES OF WATERSALELICENSE[SEC. 59. No]
20	<u>A</u> person shall <u>not</u> have or maintain [any park, enclosure] <u>a</u>
21	lake or body of water for the purpose of keeping or propagating
