19	A. The willful misrepresentation of the age or
20	condition of a motor vehicle by [any person] <u>a seller</u> ,
21	including regrooving tires or performing [chassis] repair,
22	without informing the purchaser of the vehicle that the
23	regrooving or [chassis] repair has been performed, is an
24	unlawful practice within the meaning of the Unfair Practices
25	Act, unless the alleged misrepresentation is based wholly on

Except as provided in Subsections C and D of 8 this section, a seller of a motor vehicle shall furnish at the 9 time of sale of a motor vehicle an affidavit that: 10 describes the vehicle; and (1)11 (2)states to the best of the seller's 12 knowledge whether there has been an alteration or [chassis] 13 repair due to wreck damage. 14 С. No affidavit shall be required pursuant to this 15 section if the flat rate manual cost of the alteration or 16 [chassis] repair is less than six percent of the sales price of 17 the vehicle. 18 D. In the case of a private-party sale of a 19 vehicle, an affidavit shall be furnished only upon the request 20 of the purchasing party. 21 E. A seller of a used motor vehicle shall conduct a 22 reasonable inspection of the motor vehicle before offering it 23 for sale. The seller shall disclose in writing to the 24 purchaser before the sale is completed any material mechanical 25 defect in the motor vehicle and any damage sustained by the . 145872. 1

9	(1) "known" means that a seller or the
10	seller's agent or employee has obtained facts or information
11	about the condition of a motor vehicle that would lead a
12	reasonable person in similar circumstances to believe that the
13	motor vehicle contained one or more material mechanical
14	<u>defects. "Known" includes knowledge obtained through an</u>
15	inspection, from a previous owner, from the salesperson at an
16	auction or another seller, or through other means;
17	<u>(2) "material mechanical defect" means a</u>
18	<u>defect or malfunction that renders the motor vehicle</u>
19	mechanically unsound, unsafe or inoperable; and
20	<u>(3) "seller" means a dealer or a person who</u>
21	offers a vehicle in a non-private-party transaction.
