Except as provided in Subsection C or D of this section, an insurer of homeowner's casualty shall not cancel or 2 fail to renew a homeowner's insurance policy solely because the 3 4 homeowner has made a claim pursuant to the policy. C. 5 The provisions of Subsections A and B of this section do not apply if a claim is made by a homeowner pursuant 6 7 to liability insurance coverage provided in a homeowner's 8 casualty insurance policy. 9 D. The provisions of Subsections A and B of this 10 section do not apply if other factors exist, exclusive of the 11 claim made by the homeowner, that allow for a premium increase 12 or the cancellation of or failure to renew an insurance policy 13 under the Insurance Code or rules adopted under the Insurance 14 Code.
