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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 27-2C-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2002,
17	Chapter 105, Section 3) is amended to read:
18	"27-2C-3. MEDICAID FORMULARY FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS
19	A. The department shall develop or implement a
20	formulary or preferred drug list, [that will consider] <u>taking</u>
21	into consideration the clinical efficacy, safety and cost
22	effectiveness of a product.
23	B. The department shall ensure that the
24	administration or delivery of health care services and products
25	under the medicaid program includes a formulary that will
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1	provide medically appropriate drug therapies for patients.
2	C. The department shall require a prior
3	authorization before a drug not listed on the medicaid program
4	formulary may be dispensed unless otherwise provided pursuant
5	to Subsection C of Section [4 of the Pharmaceutical
6	Supplemental Rebate Act] <u>27-2C-4 NMSA 1978.</u>
7	D. Requirements for prior authorization shall not
8	<u>apply to prescription drugs, including atypical antipsychotic</u>
9	and conventional antipsychotic medications, prescribed for
10	medicaid patients being treated for severe mental illnesses
11	that are listed in a current national diagnostic and
12	<u>statistical manual of mental disorders published by a national</u>
13	psychiatric association, including schizophrenia, clinical
14	depression, bipolar disorder, anxiety-panic attack disorder and
15	<u>obsessive compulsive disorder</u> ."
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
