16	Section 1. Section 40-1-11 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1957,
17	Chapter 33, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"40-1-11. CERTIFICATE REQUIRED
19	A. Before [any] <u>a</u> county clerk issues [any] <u>a</u>
20	marriage license, each applicant for a marriage license shall
21	file with the county clerk a certificate from a physician
22	licensed to practice medicine [which]. <u>The</u> certificate shall
23	state that the applicant has had [those] <u>the</u> tests and
24	examinations [as] required by [regulation] <u>rule</u> of the [health
25	and environment] department [Such] <u>of health. The</u> tests and

examinations shall be made not more than thirty days prior to the date of application for license. The certificate shall state that medical evaluation or that treatment, as indicated, has been made such that there is no bar to marriage, as specified by the [regulations] rules of the [health and environment] department of health.

B. The certificate of the physician shall be on a form to be provided and distributed by the <u>public</u> health [services] division to all officers authorized to issue marriage licenses and to all physicians within the state.

C. The secretary of health [and environment] shall make rules [and regulations] and employ personnel necessary to effectuate the purposes of Sections 40-1-11 through 40-1-13 NMSA 1978. If [regulations] rules require a laboratory test, it shall be done in a laboratory approved by the secretary of health [and environment].

D. A county clerk shall accept, in lieu of the physician's certificate, a certificate from any other state having premarital laws, if issued within the time limits prescribed in Subsection A of this section and if [such] the laws meet the [regulations] rules of the secretary of health [and environment].

E. The county clerk shall receive a fee of twentyfive dollars (\$25.00) for issuing, acknowledging and recording a marriage license and marriage certificate. [Fifteen dollars .145482.1
