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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
16	A. Three million six hundred eleven thousand three
17	hundred thirty-six dollars (\$3,611,336) is appropriated from
18	the DWI program fund to the department of health for
19	expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to fund the operation of an
20	eight-county regional alcohol treatment center and intensive
21	after-care and transitional living programs in Curry, De Baca,
22	Guadalupe, Harding, Quay, Roosevelt, San Miguel and Union
23	counties as follows:
24	(1) two million four hundred nineteen thousand
25	dollars (\$2,419,000) to fund the operation of a regional
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1 alcohol treatment center and inpatient alcohol treatment 2 facility in Fort Summer in De Baca county that will provide 3 for: 4 alcohol treatment services to (a) 5 residents of Curry, De Baca, Guadalupe, Harding, Quay, Roosevelt, San Miguel and Union counties; 6 7 (b) payment for the use of the facility, 8 utilities, supplies, office equipment and salaries of treatment 9 providers and support staff; and 10 (c) quality assurance and evaluation 11 services to monitor alcohol-related statistics; and 12 one million one hundred ninety-two (2)13 thousand three hundred thirty-six dollars (\$1, 192, 336) for 14 intensive after-care and transitional living programs that will 15 enhance and supplement existing programs in Curry, De Baca, 16 Guadalupe, Harding, Quay, Roosevelt, San Miguel and Union 17 counties, including: 18 (a) a comprehensive alcohol treatment 19 after-care and follow-up program; 20 a youth treatment and after-care **(b)** 21 program; 22 (c) a transportation system to and from 23 the regional alcohol treatment center; 24 a coordination, planning and (d) 25 evaluation program to be administered by no fewer than two . 145434. 1 - 2 -

representatives from the county health and wellness councils of 2 each county;

a board of advisers representing (e) each county that will participate in alcohol prevention- and treatment-related training programs. A board member shall not receive compensation for the performance of his duties but shall be paid per diem and mileage for attendance at board and 8 training meetings as provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act; and

a quality assurance and evaluation (f) services program to monitor alcohol-related statistics.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining **B**. at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the DWI program fund.
