20	<u>A.</u> A municipality may lay out, establish, open,
21	vacate, alter, repair, widen, extend, grade, pave or otherwise
22	improve streets, including but not necessarily limited to
23	median and divider strips, parkways and boulevards, alleys,
24	avenues, sidewalks, curbs, gutters and public grounds, and may:

7	<u>B. A municipality shall not erect or maintain</u>
8	artificial rises, including speed bumps and speed humps, that
9	reduce the speed of vehicles below the speed limit upon
10	streets. For the purposes of this section:
11	(1) "speed bump" means a traffic barrier or
12	restraint that rises at least three inches from the street
13	surface and is at least one foot in length; and
14	(2) "speed hump" means a traffic barrier or
15	restraint that rises between one and three inches above the
16	street surface and is at least one foot in length."
