8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
9 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the economic development department  
10 and the tourism department be requested to develop a proposal  
11 to promote golf in New Mexico; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the economic development  
13 department and the tourism department be requested to invite  
14 representatives from the golf industry in New Mexico, including  
15 private, public and university representatives, professional  
16 and amateur golf representatives, Native American  
17 representatives and youth golf representatives, to assist with  
18 the development of a proposal to promote golf in New Mexico and  
19 to report findings and recommendations to the legislative  
20 finance committee and other appropriate interim committees of  
21 the legislature; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
23 transmitted to the secretaries of economic development and  
24 tourism.
