NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, that the following new proposed Joint Rule 11-1 be adopted to read:

"LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF BILLS INTRODUCED BY A LEGISLATOR (11-1)

- A. No member of the house of representatives or of the senate shall introduce more than ten bills during a legislative session.
 - B. Excluded from each legislator's total are:

 - (2) simple or joint memorials; and
 - (3) resolutions.
- C. The limitation may be suspended in either house by a two-thirds' vote in that house.
