## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTI ON

 ADOPTI NG A LEG SLATI VE J ONT RULE ESTABLI SHI NG DEADLI NES FOR ACTI ON ON LEG SLATI ON FOR THE FORTY- SI XTH LEGI SLATURE.WHEREAS, Legi slative Joi nt Rule 8-1 provi des for the adoption, amendment or repeal of j oint rul es by concurrent resol ution approved by two-thirds of the nembershi p of each house;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES, THE SENATE CONCURRI NG THEREI $N$, that the following new joint rule be adopted to read:
"BI LLS AND RESOLUTI ONS -
DEADLI NE FOR PASSAGE FROM HOUSE OF ORI GI N During any regul ar session of the forty-sixth I egi slature, a bill or resol ution, with the
exception of a general appropriation bill, bills to
provi de for the current expenses of the government, any other bill making appropriations or raising revenue and bills introduced after the deadl ine for the introduction of bills pursuant to a referral to the I egi sl at ure by the governor by speci al message specifically setting forth the emergency or necessity requi ring such legi slation, that has not passed its house of origin by the twent $y$ - seventh cal endar day of a sessi on convened in an evennumbered year and the fifty-seventh cal endar day of a sessi on convened in an odd- number ed year shall be deemed I ost and shall not be considered by ei ther house. For the purposes of this rule, the computation of time shall be as provided in Section 12-2A-7 NMEA 1978.".
