AN ACT

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTRACT FOR INFORMATIONAL
CLEARINGHOUSE SERVICES BETWEEN NON-NATIVE AND NATIVE
COMMUNITIES AND REGIONAL RESOURCES.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year
2005 to contract for the services of an informational
clearinghouse between non-native communities and native
communities, providing information on Native American issues,
including information on substance abuse; adult and family
counseling services; establishing credit and obtaining loans;
tax filing assistance; interpretation; cultural activities; and
native foods introduction and facility usage for indigent**
