AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND STATEWIDE PROGRAMS FOR THE HOMELESS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$290,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2004 and 2005 to match federal funds in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to help fund programs for the mentally ill homeless, including transitional housing for victims of domestic violence and permanent housing for the mentally ill homeless; and

(2) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to

3 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
4 at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general
5 fund.

6 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
