11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADJACENT LANDS AT  
12 SUGARITE, MANZANO AND OTHER LEGISLATURE-APPROVED STATE PARKS  
13 FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE OF THE COTTONWOOD-WALNUT CREEK  
14 PROPERTY IN EDDY COUNTY.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--The proceeds from the sale of  
18 the Cottonwood-Walnut Creek property in Eddy county are  
19 appropriated to the state parks division of the energy,  
20 minerals and natural resources department for expenditure in  
21 fiscal years 2004 through 2014 for the purpose of matching  
22 federal funds and purchasing adjacent lands at Sugarite and  
23 Manzano state parks or at other parks authorized or to be  
24 authorized for acquisition by the legislature. This  
25 appropriation is contingent upon legislative ratification and
