11 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO FUND PRIMARY HEALTH CARE CLINICS AND
12 TO PURCHASE NEEDED TECHNOLOGY.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION--CAPITAL FUND.--One million two
16 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the
17 general fund to the primary care capital fund for expenditure
18 in fiscal year 2005 and subsequent fiscal years by the New
19 Mexico mortgage finance authority for the purpose of making
20 loans to primary health care clinics pursuant to the Primary
21 Care Capital Funding Act. Money in the fund shall not revert
22 at the end of a fiscal year.

23 Section 2. APPROPRIATION--TECHNOLOGY.--One million two
24 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the
25 general fund to the department of health for a one-time

1 nonrecurring expenditure in fiscal year 2005 for the purpose of
2 providing funds for the acquisition of improved hardware and
3 software technology for electronic billing, tracking and health

6 or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
7 2005 shall revert to the general fund.
