

HOUSE CAPITAL OUTLAY REQUEST 1210

REQUESTED BY Daniel P. Silva

FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN HOUSE DISTRICT 13 AND ALBUQUERQUE IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

- to the state agency on aging

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the construction of an exercise room at the Los Volcanes senior center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

- to the department of transportation

thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to resurface streets in the Alamosa area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$145,000) for landscaping improvements on the Bataan medians in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for improving the tennis court at Alamosa park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for equipping the Alamosa dental clinic in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to design and construct park improvements at Desert Spring park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to acquire land for, plan and design the development of the Meridan business park as a major westside employment center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to design and construct park improvements, including utilities, parking, streets, fencing and bleachers, for Westgate little league at Eighty-sixth street and Tower road SW in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to design and construct improvements for the community park at Delgado and Rio Puerco in the Westgate area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county; and

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to acquire land for, plan, design and construct the Unser children's discovery center and racing museum in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county; and

- to the public education department

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for educational technology at West Mesa high school, Jimmy E. Carter and Truman middle schools and Alamosa, Carlos Rey, Lavaland and Mary Ann Binford elementary schools in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county; and

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to renovate and construct Nuestros Valores charter school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county.
