ENCOURAGING THE GOVERNOR TO CONSIDER LOCATING HIS PROPOSED
FILM INSTITUTE IN SANTA FE.

A. an existing infrastructure to support technical training for the film

and motivated residents, groups and partnerships;

D. a concentration of individuals with technical and artistic skills
available to work on film-related projects; and

E. the advantage of working in close proximity to state government
to facilitate quick response programs and systems; and
