### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 149 amends 22-10A-15 to remove authorization for local school boards to provide for additional qualifications for substitute teachers.

#### Significant Issues

Senate Bill 149 removes the authority of local school districts to issue substitute teacher certificates and directs the PED to certify substitute teachers.

### ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

According to PED, there would be an initial large number of applications to cover those substitute teachers who were certified in 2003-2004 by local school districts, once that has worked its way through the system the administrative impact would become routine.
