#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 35 requests the PED and DOH collaborate in a study of methods to increase the physical activity and improve the eating habits of youth.

#### Significant Issues

According to DOH and PED, they are currently in the planning stages for conducting a forum on physical activity and nutrition issues in schools. This forum could be utilized to implement the study requested in SJM35.
