## A JOINT MEMORIAL

WHEREAS, tens of thousands of educators and other school employees are relying on the educational retirement board to provide for their financial well-being during retirement; and

WHEREAS, it is important to ensure that the educational retirement board's pension fund is actuarially sound to protect current and future retirees and to maintain the trust that current and future retirees have placed in the retirement .150889.1
